## Eligibility

The call for public images *Image... sent, Image... envoyée* is open to any resident of France or Canada. French or Canadian citizens living abroad can also participate, provided they send images related to their country of origin.

## Application

Candidates must send their image **exclusively by digital means**. Each person may send **only one image**. Only the person's first name or social media handle will be indicated (no title, no text) as well as the origin of the image (Canada or France)

.The accepted format for photographs is vertical or horizontal. The accepted file type is: .jpeg, minimum 5 megapixels (5MP) and maximum 10MB.

The images will be selected by our curator and you will be notified of your selection for the virtual exhibition by June 30th. The images selected for the physical exhibition will be printed on a common graphic medium to give visual unity to the project.
